Track Day Sessions	On 1 July (8 hours) and 2 July (8 hours) you have the possibility to book the CR Track Day Sessions. Each day offers a total of 8 hours of track time, divided into two open pit lane sessions, with a lunch break in between. The following cars will be on track during these sessions: GT3, GTX, Porsche 911 GT3 Cup (992), LMP2, Radical and GT4. Bookings can be made by sending an email to proto@creventic.com .
Team Registration	Upon arrival at the circuit, please visit the Welcome Center to collect your event service bag. The Welcome Center will be in the CREVENTIC Endurance Lounge. Please note that all items, excluding parking passes and stickers, are issued once for the full season. From Friday onwards, strict access checks will be in place. The number of passes provided per team is in accordance with the event regulations. Additional passes can be purchased at the Welcome Center.

Admin Check	All drivers and team managers are required to complete the administrative check via the CREVENTIC application. We strongly recommend completing the administrative check well in advance, so that your details can be verified in time and any missing or incorrect information can be resolved before the event. Please note that all information must be fully completed no later than Thursday, 2 July. If any information is missing or not in order after this deadline, this may result in drivers not being permitted to take part in the official sessions on Friday.
Team Manager & Driver Pictures	All drivers are required to have a portrait photo taken, unless a picture was taken at R1 Mugello. The photo session will take place on Thursday 2 July from 13:00–13:30. Location: TBA

Track Walk	Tuesday 30 June: 18.30 – 20:00 Wednesday 1 July: 18:15 - 20:00 Thursday 2 July: 18:15 - 20:00
Michelin Tyres	Only tyres ordered via the official order form of our Michelin supplier Bardi can be used during both testing and official sessions of the weekend. Michelin will be present with a service from Tuesday evening onwards. For the first event a team is allowed to buy 4 new sets for all the official sessions. From the 2nd race onwards 2 carry-over sets can be nominated, while 3 new sets can be bought. For testing there is no limitation on the number of tyres used. Deadline for ordering tyres is the 18th of June. Michelin Tyre Prices 2026 / Tyre Order is added to our website Bardi Racing will be located on the paddock.
Fuel	Fuel can be collected from the fuel station at the beginning of the pit lane. Teams must bring their own fuel drums. Refuelling is permitted throughout Wednesday and Thursday, provided that all personnel involved wear a firesuit. From Friday, the fuel station will only be available during specific time slots as published in the app. Firesuits will not be required during these time slots. All teams will receive a personal refueling tag. A refundable downpayment of €50 cash applies. In addition, each team must pay a fuel downpayment of €875 per car in advance, covering 350 liters of fuel. Any unused fuel will be credited after the event, while any additional fuel used beyond 350 liters will be charged afterwards. For track days we will also charge 350 liters in advance. Same rules apply as for the official sessions as mentioned above. Technical data sheet of the fuel is added on our website: LINK
Scrutineering	The scrutineering timeslot is scheduled for Thursday, 2 July, from 17:00 to 18:30. The scrutineering itself will be done in your paddock allocation.
Tyre Nomination	Tyres must be nominated through the file added to our website. According to the regulations this must be done at the latest Thursday 18:00. The file is added to our website.
Catering	There will be catering available for breakfast, lunch and dinner from Wednesday to Sunday in the Creventic Endurance Lounge. Click here for the catering order form. Deadline: 17 June For drivers catering is included.

Noise Regulations	Please be aware that noise limitations may apply during the event: • 130 dB(A) measured in accordance with the LWA procedure (measured by DSMB). • 98 dB(A) measured in accordance with the LP procedure (measured by DSMB). Please keep these limits in mind. We will provide further updates as soon as more information becomes available.

Paddock Information

All teams using workshop tents are required to comply with the Nürburgring workshop tent regulations. A permit is required for any tent or temporary structure exceeding 75 m² in surface area or 5 m in height. Where applicable, a valid German Prüfbuch must be provided.

Please note that the 75 m² limit also applies to:

- A truck with an attached awning, where the combined surface area of the truck and awning exceeds 75 m².
- A truck and a separate tent, where the total surface area exceeds 75 m².

If your setup exceeds 75 m² and no valid Prüfbuch is available, you must use a separate tent of less than 75 m² that is not connected to the truck. In this case, no certification is required for the tent.

The paddock must be completely empty on Sunday by 18:00.

Electrical Equipment & Pressure Cylinders

All teams are required to comply with the Nürburgring regulations regarding electrical equipment and the use of pressure cylinders. The information document can be found in the attachments.

Since the original document is in German, the following points have been identified as the most relevant for your operations:

- Electrical equipment must meet applicable VDE safety standards.
- Maximum 2 pressurised air cylinders per pit box or team area on the paddock.
- Only cylinders actually required for operation may be present inside the pit box or on the team area in the paddock.
- Changing cylinders during operation is not permitted.
- Spare cylinders may not be stored inside the pit box or on the team area in the paddock.
